Examination

On completion of the course there is a written five-hours exam. The maximum number of points that can be obtained is 100 (45 for E, 50 for D, 60 for C, 75 for B and 90 for A).

In the course there is a voluntary seminar series with five seminar exercises. Pass on the seminar series gives a 10-points credit in the final exam. This means that you start the final exam with 10 points and will have to answer only four questions. Those without credit have to answer an additional question which can give up to 10 points.

Seminar tasks should be solved in groups consisting of 3-4 students. The answers should be submitted to the seminar teacher latest at 12 o'clock the day before the seminar. Answers must be provided to *all* seminars. Physical participation is required at four of the five seminars.
