The beauty of attending Development at SU is that there are so many teachers covering all the span of topics of the subject. However, it will be great if they elect (officially) a director for the course, who is in charge of homogenizing the material and the structure of the presentations.

Perhaps helpful would be a replication exercise. For instance, make part of the students' evaluation to replicate a paper, using real data and do files, to understand issues such as data cleaning and management in a development context.

Presentations were helpful in introducing the student to a critical reading of the topics. Referee reports were also needed.
