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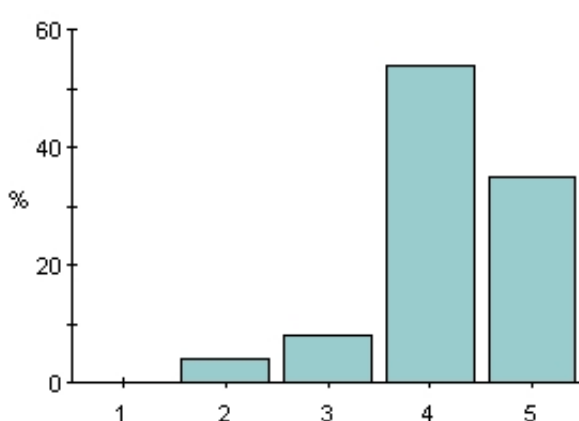

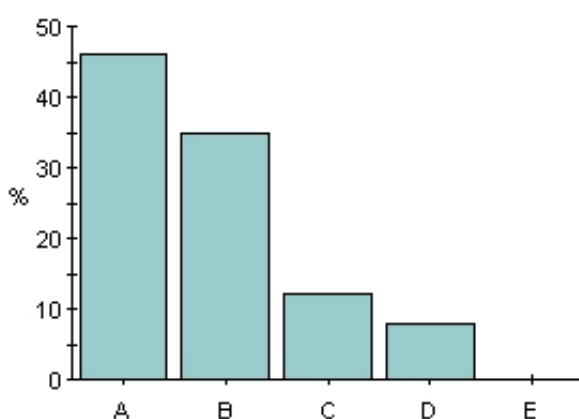

Approximately, how many hours per week did you spend studying during this course? (including lectures and seminars/exercises)

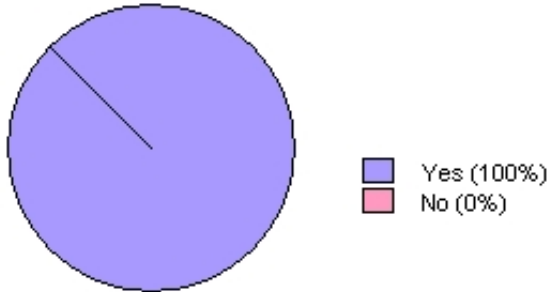

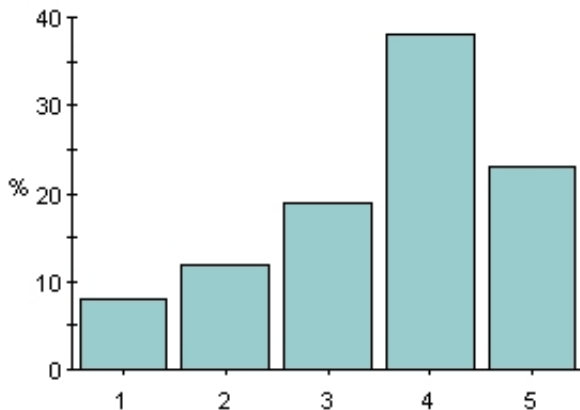
Have you read the course literature?

What is your opinion on the course literature? (assuming you read it)

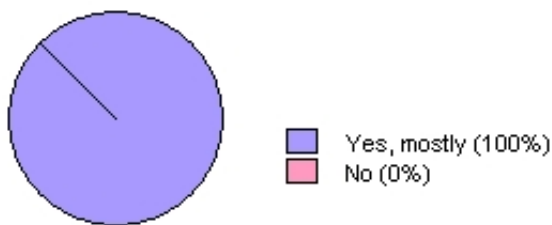

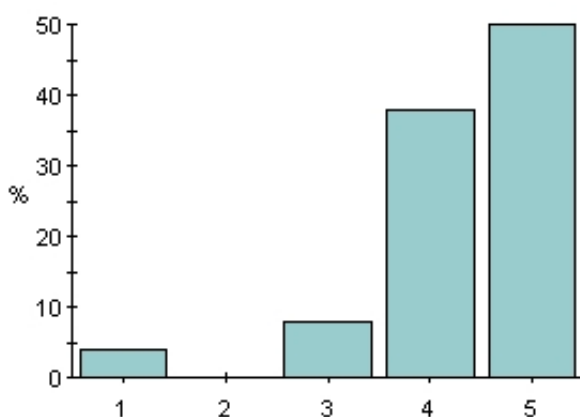

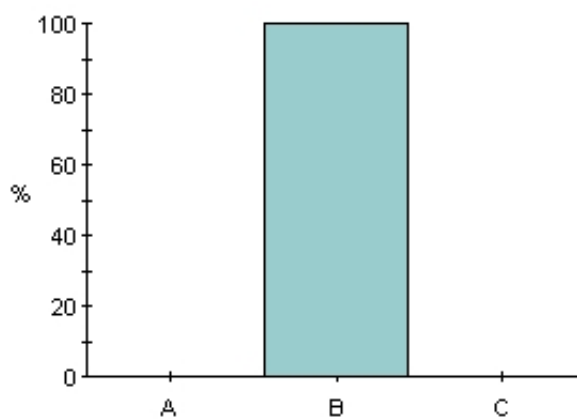
Did you usually read the literature before you attended lectures?

What is your opinion on the level of difficulty of the lectures?

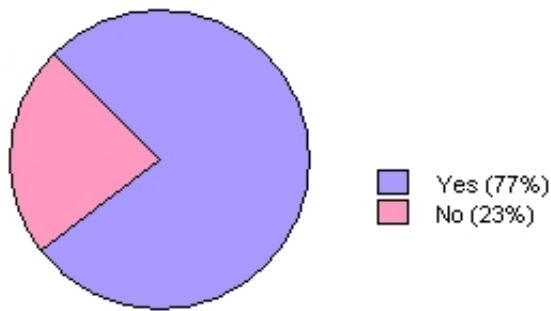

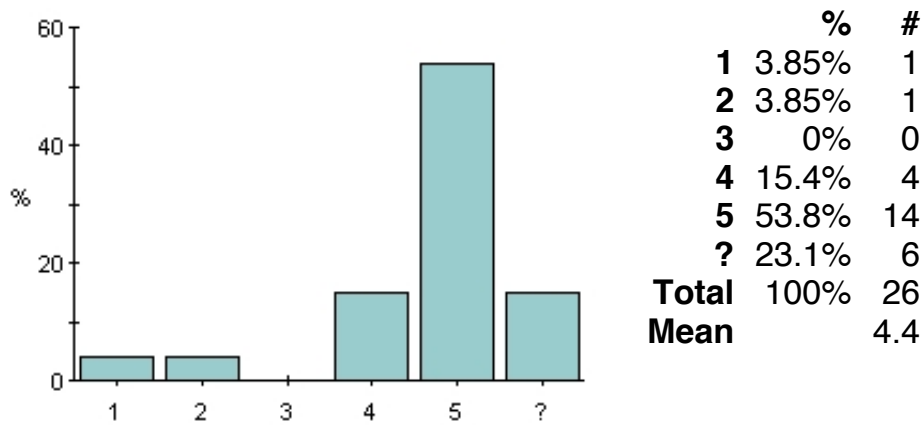

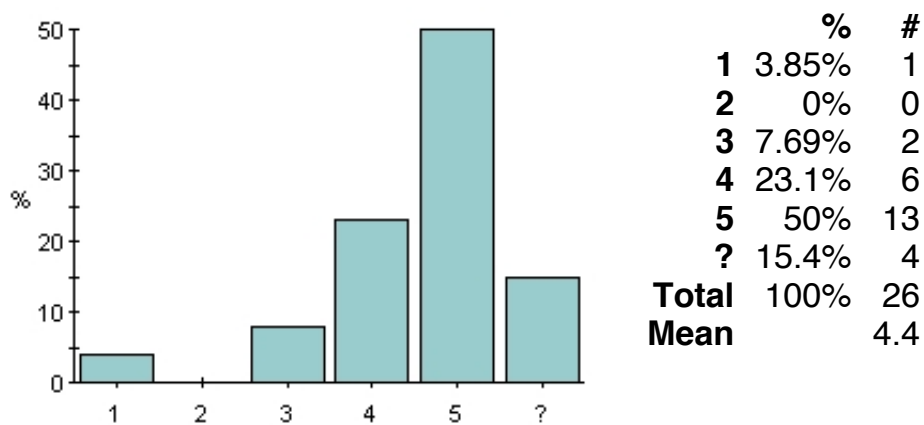


How well did the exam reflect the course in your view?

- I think that the book for the course, Understanding Poverty by Banerjee et al, was indeed a very interesting book, and I will continue to read it even though the course is now over. However, I don't think it reflected the course very well. Perhaps some other book is available that fits the course better? Otherwise, I believe that just the articles would suffice as course literature.
- I am overall very satisfied and happy I took this course. It was interesting to combine theory and empirics in this way. Konrad was always well-prepared and pedagogical.
- Concerning the lectures, it would be good if they started at the full hour and kept going for 45 min and then you have a break for 15 min. Unfortunately this was seldom the case this term. Put the lecture slides up on mondo at least 24h before the lecture. About the presentations by the end of the course, one idea would be to divide the class with its groups into two groups, so that all groups don't have to listen to presentations for four hours... Unfortunately I don't think many of us were able to keep concentrated for that long, so a split of the class would have been good. Except these small practicalities, all in all a very interesting course well and pedagogically taught by Konrad B.
